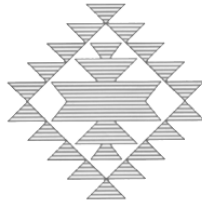


# Michael Peter Macaluso Endowed Scholarship



## **SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES & CRITERIA**

The application deadline is February 1st of each year. All applications must be received at the Center for the Study of the Southwest, Brazos Hall, Room 212, before 5 p.m. A member of the selection committee will notify the scholarship recipient.

Eligibility and scholarship criteria include:

- ◆ being a declared Southwestern Studies minor;
- ◆ being a full-time junior or senior at Texas State;
- ◆ having a minimum 3.0 overall GPA; and
- ◆ submitting a completed application

## **REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS**

- ◆ a statement not to exceed 500 words addressing career intentions and the effect coursework, extracurricular activities, and work experience will have on applicant's future;
- ◆ three recommendations from faculty or staff who have taught, advised, and/or supervised the applicant; and
- ◆ one official copy of applicant's transcript
