If you feel you meet all the listed criteria, click on the Tuition Rebate Form link. Print the form, complete, and submit to the ADVISING CENTER

no later than the last business day before the commencement ceremony. (You will be notified of your eligibility or ineligibility within 6 weeks after grades post for the semester.)

Thank you for submitting your application.

Texas law provides the option of receiving a tuition rebate of up to \$1,000 if:

- You enrolled for the first time in an institution of higher education between the fall 1997 semester and the summer II 2005 semester. OR
- You enrolled for the first time in fall 2005 or later, graduated within four calendar years from the first semester enrolled or within five calendar years for a five-year degree if the degree is architecture. engineering or any other program determined by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board to require more than four years to complete. AND
- You attempted no more than three hours in excess of the minimum number of semester credit hours required to complete the degree under the catalog under which you graduated.
- You requested a rebate for work related to a first baccalaureate degree received from a Texas public university.
- You have been a resident of Texas and have been entitled to pay resident tuition at all times while pursuing the degree.

I understand that if I do request a rebate I must complete a separate application form to determine my eligibility. I also understand that if I do not complete the application form prior to graduation I will not be considered for the tuition rebate.
