Eligibility:

- U.S. citizen
- 21 years of age
- Graduate or undergraduate (sophomores & juniors in current academic year)
- Majoring in environmental science, natural resource management, biology, public policy, geography, political science, or related.
- One year of scholarship support only.

Reward:

- (2005) minimum of ten scholarships at \$10,000 each
- used for: tuition, fees, books, room & board, direct expenses related to studies
- last year: 15 scholarships awarded out of 300 applications received

Application Process:

- Academic objectives essay: \leq 1500 words
 - Focus on broader aspects and impacts of research w/ regards to conservation.
 - Check out the website for more details.
- Proposed title and short abstract for proposed research
- Attached 1 - 2 page research plan
- 3 letters of recommendation: (2 must be from faculty who the student has directly worked under)
- official transcripts from all colleges attended.
