



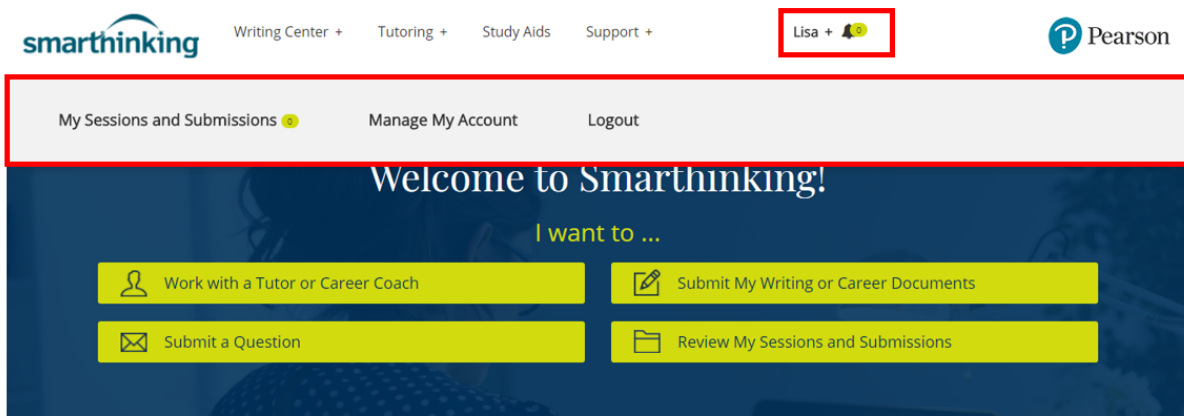
## Guide for Activating Text Messaging in Smarthinking

You can receive text messages from Smarthinking for the following instances:

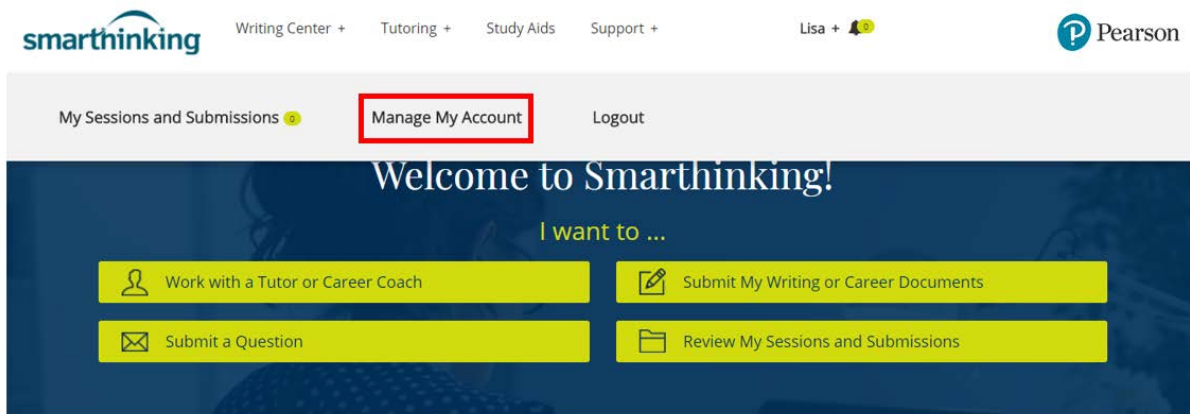
- When a paper has been returned from the Essay Writing Center
- When a submitted question has been returned
- When you have a scheduled tutoring session starting soon

To opt in to receive text messaging, you need to input your mobile phone number to your Smarthinking profile and select “Yes” to opt in to the service. Follow the instructions below.

1. Login to Smarthinking.
2. Select your name to open the menu that includes Manage My Account.



3. Select “Manage My Account.”



4. Select “edit account” under Profile.
