INSTRUCTIONS FOR SOCIAL WORK MAJOR (BSW PHASE II) APPLICATION

Admission to Phase II of the BSW Program requires that you, a student, submit a complete, high-quality application. The application must be reflective of both your high level academic skills, and your understanding of the basics of the social work profession. The Application form is available to download online [download here] and in hard copy form in the Social Work Office, HPB 150. Applications are accepted twice a year. The application deadlines are:

In November and in April (April 17th for FALL 2017 admission)

Eligibility

Phase II applicants must have completed the minimum of 45 semester credit hours, including the following courses, to be eligible to apply:

- ENG 1310 AND 1320
- COMM 1310
- MATH 1315 OR 1319
- BIO 1320 AND 1421

- PHIL 1305 OR PHIL 1320
- SOWK 1350 AND 2375
- HIST 1310 AND 1320
- US 1100 (not required for transfer students)

Applicants must have attained **a minimum 2.50 overall GPA**, **and 2.75 in social work courses**. Students should submit an unofficial transcript (via CATSWEB) with their BSW application.



The Application Packet

The application items are listed below. Please follow instructions carefully.

• The Application for the Social Work Major form

Complete this form. Note that several questions require a narrative response. Format your narrative responses with a header to include your name in the lefthand corner and the page number in the right-hand corner. Page numbers should be in the form of "1 of 5" or "2 of 5." Number your responses to correspond with the questions you are answering. Double space your narrative (12 point Times New Roman or 13 point Arial) with 1 inch margins.

The Pre-Major Performance Evaluation forms

Complete the top portion of these forms. Give one form to your SOWK 2375 volunteer supervisor, and either your SOWK 1350 instructor or your SOWK 2375 instructor (or similar social work courses for transfer students). You are responsible for ensuring that the evaluations are received by the application deadline to the School of Social Work. Missing evaluations will make your application incomplete, meaning it will NOT be reviewed by the admissions committee.

• If you took SOWK 1350 or 2375 at another school and your instructor is no longer available, or if you have other significant problems obtaining evaluations, please contact the BSW Director.

Complete this form. Submit with your application (NOT to the Dean's Office).

• The Checklist for Social Work Major Applicants

This form is provided to help you keep track of required materials. Check that you have completed all parts of your application. Complete and submit this from with your application.

Application Decisions Procedure

The BSW Admissions Committee reviews each application and makes one of two decisions: (1) Admission, or (2) Denial. In a few instances, an admissions decision may be deferred pending additional information. Admission decisions are communicated in writing <u>by e-mail</u> a few weeks after final semester grades have been posted in May.

Appeals Procedure

If you are not satisfied with the decision of the BSW Admissions Committee concerning your application, you have the right to appeal the decision to the BSW Director. Appeals must be submitted in writing to the Director within thirty days of the date listed in the Decision Letter. **Appeals must include a specific reason for the appeal.** Timely appeals are important since students are not allowed to register for or remain in social work major classes (except electives) if they are not official majors.

- 1. Grade History. In your college work have you received a D or lower in any course? If yes, please discuss and explain your reason for the grade in each case.
- 2. Motivation to enter the social work program, and join the social work profession. Briefly describe **your three main reasons** for wishing to enter the social work program.
 - Also, discuss professional goals which you feel a BSW degree will help you accomplish. Be specific.
- 3. Stressful Situations. Social workers frequently have to deal with stressful situations. We all encounter difficult situations from time to time. **Briefly describe a recent stressful situation** that you encountered.
 - Explain how you handled this stressful situation. Be specific.
- 4. Strengths and Challenges. All human beings have strengths and resources, as well as limitations and barriers which influence access to life goals. List at least three strengths and resources you possess that you feel will help you to become an effective social worker. Discuss how they will help you.
 - List at least three limitations or barriers that you are working to overcome so that they do not prevent you from becoming an effective social worker. Be specific.
- 5. Essay. Select **one of the current topics from the list provided.** Based on your understanding of the concept of social justice, discuss the social justice issues posed by this topic. In your discussion, identify the specific issues? Describe how these Issues relate to the core values of the social work profession. Also, describe how these issues relate to your own personal values?

<u>Do not</u> simply describe the topic. The selection committee is interested in your critical analysis of the topic, and your reaction to **how the topic issues relate to (a) social justice**, **(b) social work's professional values, and (c) your personal values. (Limit = 500 words)**

- Immigration, Refugees, and Citizenship in Today's United States
- Access to Healthcare Services as a Right or a Privilege
- The Criminal Justice System and Excessive Force
- Home, School, and Community Needs for the LGBTQ Community
- Substance Abuse as a Need for Treatment or as a Crime Needing Incarceration
