Job Description: Pool Maintenance Worker will assist Assistant Director with the daily operations of the Student Recreation Center Natatorium and provide him/her with input in reference to policy and procedures.

Qualifications:

- Strong work ethic and ability to work without direct supervision
- Ability to lift, push and pull 55 pounds

Job Specifics:

- Cleaning and sanitizing tile, stainless steel and deck areas
- Trash and lost and found detail work
- Vacuum pools on a weekly basis
- Scrub and brush tile and vertical walls of pools and floor
- Utilize and maintain floor scrubbing machine and power washing equipment
- Test water chemistry and log findings
- Replenish chlorine and acid supplies
- Assist in maintaining a clean and safe work environment
- Complete other duties as assigned

Scheduling:

- Employee can set their own hours around the pool schedule with certain caveats

Evaluation:

- Assist in the evaluation and maintain inventory of all equipment for the pool
- Log in all performed maintenance

Other:
